Becky Brown's popular Horsemanship Summer Camp will be offered at BuckBranch Farm again this year. Camps for complete beginners to advanced riders aged five and up meet Monday through Friday. In addition to riding, each session covers safety, grooming, tacking up, veterinary care, and more. Classes are grouped according to age and skill level with qualified instructors, well-trained horses and lots of one-on-one attention.

Please send your camper in appropriate riding attire: long pants or breeches, riding helmet (some available on loan), and boots or hard soled shoes with a 1" heel (no sneakers or hiking boots). Also include a snack (refrigeration available) & water jug.

Camp Descriptions and Fees:

Level IV Advanced Competition Camp Open to riders comfortable jumping 2'6" with basic dressage skills. Students will explore the new cross-country jumping course! Included will be intense theory and practicum on riding, nutrition, and basic vet skills. Limited enrollment. Fee: \$500

Level III Intermediate Camp For riders who have taken lessons more than a year and can comfortably walk, trot, canter, and take small fences. Limited enrollment. Fee: \$500

Level II Beginner/Intermediate Camp. Divided into two sections: first time riders and riders of limited riding experience. Includes arena and trail riding, horsemanship theory, riding games and lots of fun! Minimum age: 8 years old. Fee: \$400

Level I Pony Kamp: Open to 5-7 yr olds with little or no riding experience. Campers will ride and learn horsemanship theory appropriate for age. Taught in a fun playful atmosphere. These spots fill fast! Fee \$300

Adult Evening Camp: Beginner/Competition: Curriculum includes private long lessons, group dressage lessons, small fences and an evening trail ride. Level of riding will be determined by applicant's prior experience. Enrollment limited. Fee \$500.
